CELL PHONE / ELECTRONIC DEVICES / ANY MOBILE DEVICE

It is the policy of the Meriwether County Board of Education that cell phones and electronic devices/equipment are permitted to be within the student's possession; however, cell phones/ electronic devices/equipment **must not be in use and/or visible during school hours.**

During any time of testing, a student within the Meriwether County School System shall not have any electronic devices, be it a cell phone or any other electronic communication device within their possession.

Violation of this rule shall result in punishment per the Meriwether County School System's Code of Conduct.

The Meriwether County School System is not responsible for lost, stolen and/or damaged cell phones or electronic devices/equipment.

Confiscated cell phones and other electronic devices/equipment will be returned at the discretion of the principal or his or her designee to the parent or guardian.
