# Right to Know Professional Qualifications of Teachers and Paraprofessionals

Dear Parents,

In compliance with the requirements of the Every Students Succeeds Act, the Meriwether County School System would like to inform you that you may request information about the professional qualifications of your student's teacher(s) and/ or paraprofessional(s). The following information may be requested:

- Whether the student's teacher—
  - has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
  - is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived; and
  - is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

If you wish to request information concerning your child's teacher's and/ or paraprofessional's qualifications, please contact Dr. Marci Vining, *Director of Human Resources* at [706-441-0601].

1. Ya sea que el maestro del estudiante:  
ha cumplido con los criterios estatales de calificación y licencia para los niveles de grado y las materias en las que el maestro imparte instrucción.  
está enseñando bajo emergencia u otro estado provisional a través del cual se ha renunciado a los criterios de calificación o licencia del Estado; y  
es la enseñanza en el campo de la disciplina de la certificación del maestro.
2. Si el niño recibe servicios de paraprofesionales y, de ser así, sus calificaciones.
